Queen of Angels Fine Art Fair VII is an annual one-day, free admission fair where 33 artists exhibit and sell their work in the historic parish meeting hall often attracting over 1000 visitors.



"My Father" is blind juried by participating artists with three prizes, \$400, \$300 & \$200.

Sunnyside Artists, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization. 10% of entry fees of \$45 go to local food pantries. \$30 returned to artists not selected. All sales from either show belong entirely to the artist. 718 909 4806 | 45-06 Queens Blvd #166 Sunnyside NY 11104

BASIC PROCESS:

- A. Submit two jpegs of artwork in an email with a subject line, "June2014."
- **B.** Title each jpeg, (may be from any date), with your name and number 1 or 2, with YOUR NAME, such as "vanGogh1" and "vanGogh2." **Include in email your name, address and phone number.** Email to SunnysideArtists@gmail before midnight, April 27, 2014.
- **C.** By US mail or drop off to address on entry form, and include an entry fee of \$45 check or money order made out to "Sunnyside Artists." Please print out the entry form on page four, fill out and include with fee. If you are not accepted into the competition for the either show, \$30 will be returned. All who enter, place or not, will receive a year of membership entitling you to retail discounts-including 10-15% in 2014 at Art & Craftsman, and a free glass of wine at the Art Fair. Those competing in "My Father," will receive instructions on voting.
- **D.** All work must be for sale. If you wish to enter work you wish to keep, perhaps choose a high enough price that if it sells, you would find the sale acceptable. And note, as artists, you can always make more.

WHAT KIND OF ARTWORK? Both pieces should be two-dimensional artwork of any size but no larger than 48 x 36 inches including frame, if any, or sculpture not larger than 30" in diameter x 60" high (inquire if you have a piece not within those dimensions) not including base, from any date (although yellowed or worn work is unacceptable), and in any media. The subject matter may relate to "My Father" in any way you like, literal or a non-literal approach. An attachment shows how other artists have treated the subject.

ELIGIBILITY: Artists (including photographers) 18 or over who live or work in Woodside, Maspeth, Long Island City, Astoria, Blissville, Maspeth, Ridgewood, Middle Village and Sunnyside. If you have a compelling reason why you should be eligible such as you grew up in Western Queens, please send your credentials and we will look into it.

ART TOPICS: If you are entering both shows, you may submit two jpegs, or at least one on the topic of "My Father." If you are entering just the Art Fair, you may enter two jpegs on any subject. If you are entering just the "My Father," at least one should be related to that theme. If you submit two on the topic of "My Father," both will be candidates for "My Father."

JPEG IMAGES: Send an accurate image of work not greater than 1.25 MB each. The jpegs, gif, or pings you send should be 72 dpi, and no more than 1000 pixels on the longest side. The images will be uploaded by an impartial technician and be uploaded under a coded name into an online gallery for voting. If you are not using jpegs yet, and need help, email us and we will try to find a volunteer to help you.

VOTING: Despite the drawbacks of online voting, we created and introduced the blind artist-jury-artists concept five years ago to positive feedback. Each artist who is accepted to compete gets to vote, with no indication of artist name. Instructions for voting and artwork submission will follow after entry process. The tallying is done by three, non-artist, non-participants to keep the process blind and fair. If you do not place in one show, but are accepted into the other, no other artists are aware of who did or did not enter. If you do not place in either show, no one is aware of your entry, and \$30 of your fee is returned.

VENUES: "My Father" will be exhibited at a local Skillman Avenue venue. Number of entries placing in the show will be approximately 25, or as many as can be reasonably mounted given the size of work submitted. The Art Fair is located at the Parish Meeting Hall at the corner of Skillman Avenue & 44th Street. This is our twelfth art event courtesy of Queen of Angels. The church loses money on our events and hosts them as a community outreach. We give the Pastor there the check for the food pantries who personally delivers it.

LEGAL & LOGISTICS: If your work is accepted for exhibit in either show, you will be sent a "hold harmless" to sign, and instructions on delivery, pick up, and logistics and/or Fair details. If your work is sold during "My Father," please inform your client that you must leave the work up until the completion of the exhibit. SunnysideArtists will provide price list/contact information sheets but does not sell, take a commission or handle any sales. If we hear of interest in your work, we try to get that information to you quickly. The venue will not handle sales or take a commission and kindly offers us only the setting for the exhibit and a discount to those wearing the Fair pin.

FEES: We never charge admission. Any money we collect on raffles or the sale of food goes to pay for pins, cards, and promotion, and other out-of-pocket expenses that we cannot find gratis. Our purpose is to encourage local artists and to provide access to the public to you. We function primarily on donated space, goods and services and with help from volunteers.

FAIR: Participants are assigned a table 2.5 x 6' or table space and two chairs and if possible, access to a wall or rolling wall.

YOUR MEDIA: We do not exclude prints, but find that artists scored one-of-a-kind works higher and visitors seem to prize them more. If you are submitting mixed media, please specify what the different media is. If you are submitting a print, price accordingly and if it is part of a limited edition, please specify. We generally refer to a "giclee" as a conservation print.

QUEENS ART EXPRESS: We were chosen as happy participants in the past, but this year, Queens Council on the Arts reports that their plan does not include the festival along the #7 train.

WEBSITE: In that it is more time consuming to post day-to-day progress on Sunnysideartists.org (we are in the process of making the website more updateable), we will post information on a speedier basis on Facebook/SunnysideArtists. If you are on Twitter, follow "Sunnyside Arts" when notified.

PROMOTION: We advertise in print and online, will attempt to get postcards for participating artists to be able to send and hand out to encourage visitors to the venue. If we can get them made, they will be provided free of charge to artists. Flyers and an emailable flyer will be made available to artists.

APPLICATION: Please print out the following 1-page entry form. Fill out in full. Enter as early as possible. The volunteers who process them will have more time, and more time to get back to you if there is a problem you might be able to address. Call Manny Gomez if you have questions about your entry.
